

## Study Notes

Data from the NIMH Data Archives were used in the Study, Predictors of self-injurious behaviour exhibited by individuals with autism spectrum disorder (published in [J Intellect Disabil Res, May 2013](#)), and included 'Archived' data. The NIMH data archives has a practice of archiving data when it has been updated (*i.e.*, replaced by more recent data) or when there were problems with the data (*e.g.*, data entry errors).

In addition to and partially because of the preceding, some subject data were duplicated. The authors mistakenly treated these data as being unique and published [a correction](#) to this effect.

As a general rule archived data are no longer accessible, except where needed to support reproducibility of results. This study includes the same data accessed by the authors. Please consider that archived data may be either out-of-date or unreliable.
